

Abraham trusts God

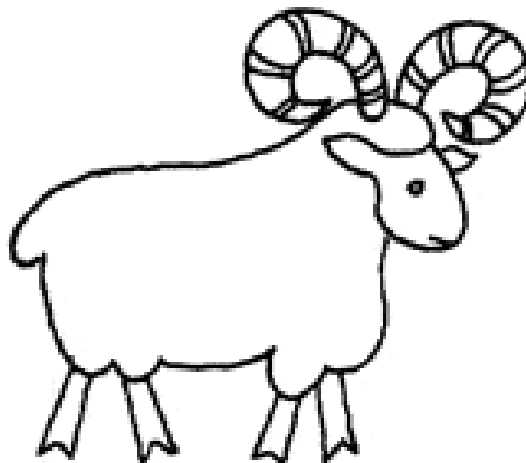
Genesis 22:1-19

1. Our fifth decoration for the Jesse Tree

Cut out the picture of the ram and stick it on card or plastic. Colour it in and stick some cotton wool on its body. Make it look a bit scraggy and dirty – it was a wild ram. Find a twiggy twig and stick the ram in it. Hang it on your Jesse Tree with a piece of ribbon or tape and write “God will provide!” on it.



2. Pray

Abraham couldn't understand what God was doing but he learned that God could be trusted and that he would provide.

When has God provided for you? *Thank him.*

Isaac was afraid, but God saved him and everything was alright in the end.

When has God helped you when you were scared? *Thank him.*

Loving Father God, when we don't understand what you're doing and when we are scared, help us to trust you, to remember that you are with us and to expect you to provide for us. Amen
